




Performance Drill Down: SAT Results







- AP courses offer college-level curriculum to high school students and many colleges will grant course credit to students who earn a certain score (usually 3 or higher) on the five point exam.

APS saw an increase (+247) in the number of Advanced Placement (AP) tests administered in 2019. The total number of tests passed also increased (+176).

Looking at the student body as a whole helps us understand what percentage of APS students are taking, testing and passing AP exams, rather than focusing on just students who took take AP tests.

KIPP had the highest percentage of the student body taking an AP course at 73%, but only 3% of their student body passed an AP exam.


Classical, Grady, Drew, and North Atlanta all had more than 10 percent of their student body pass an AP exam.



- Percentage of students who graduate high school in four years
 - Based on a cohort of students who start high school at the same time:
 - A 2020 graduation rate of 75% means that 75% of students who started high school in 2016-17 graduated in four years.
 - Students who transfer are removed from the cohort


Performance Drill Down: Graduation Rate



2020 Graduation Rates by School and Race/Ethnicity






Performance Drill Down: Graduation Rates by Subgroup over Time

APS Cohort Graduation Rates over Time






APS Seamless Enrollment by Cohort


